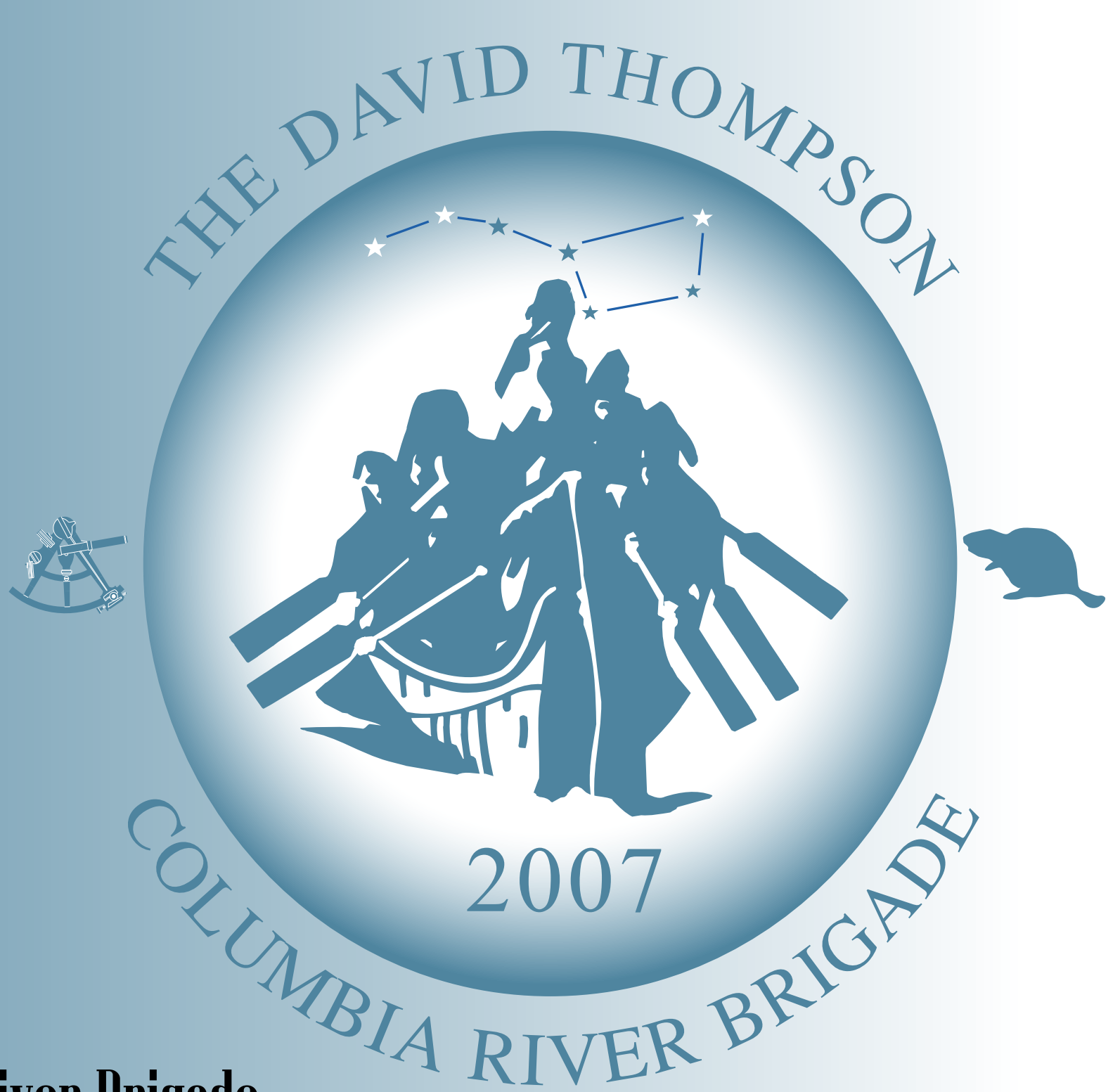

The David Thompson 2007 Columbia River Brigade

Purpose of the event:

To commemorate David Thompson's arrival on the Columbia River in 1807 and to recognize his achievements and effect on the Columbia River and Canadian History.

Scope of the event:

To lead a brigade of Voyageur Canoes from the headwaters of the Columbia River at Canal Flats to Trail, BC visiting the Columbia River Basin Communities along the way.

To provide a cultural and heritage component through the use of a professional stage show production of The David Thompson Heritage Stage Show that will involve young and old in all communities along the way.

To produce a 30 minute educational video for post event use

June 26 to July 7, 2007

The paddling part of the event will feature 25' Voyageur Canoes that seat 6 paddlers. The event will be a brigade/pageant whereby the canoes will travel together but there will be competitive aspects.
